A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the laying of gas mains and water mains
2 along highways.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty point four (320.4),
2 Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

3 320.4 WATER AND GAS MAINS, SIDEWALKS, AND CATTLEWAYS.

4 The state department of transportation in case of primary
5 roads, and the board of supervisors in case of secondary
6 roads, on written application designating the particular
7 highway and part thereof of the highway, the use of which
8 is desired, may grant permission:

9 1. To lay gas ~~and-water~~ mains in highways outside cities
10 to local municipal distributing plants or companies, but not
11 to ~~pipe-line~~ pipeline companies. This section shall not apply
12 to or include ~~pipe-line~~ pipeline companies required to obtain
13 a license from the Iowa state commerce commission.

14 2. To construct and maintain cattleways over or under
15 such highways.

16 3. To construct sidewalks on and along such highways.

17 4. To lay water mains in, under, or along highways.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill relates to the class of permittees authorized
20 to lay gas or water mains along highways. The class of
21 permittees authorized to lay gas or petroleum mains is narrowly
22 defined under this bill, but the class of permittees authorized
23 to lay water mains along highways is expanded.

24 This Act is effective July first following its enactment.

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2. To construct and maintain cattleways over or under such highways.
3. To construct sidewalks on and along such highways.
4. To lay water mains in, under, or along highways.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAYING OF GAS MAINS AND WATER MAINS ALONG HIGHWAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred twenty point four (320.4), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

320.4 WATER AND GAS MAINS, SIDEWALKS, AND CATTLEWAYS. The state department of transportation in case of primary roads, and the board of supervisors in case of secondary roads, on written application designating the particular highway and part ~~thereof~~ of the highway, the use of which is desired, may grant permission:

1. To lay gas ~~and-water~~ mains in highways outside cities to local municipal distributing plants or companies, but not to ~~pipe-line~~ pipeline companies. This section shall not apply to or include ~~pipe-line~~ pipeline companies required to obtain a license from the Iowa state commerce commission.
