1 Section 1. Section 116.20, subsection 1, Code 1981, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. The certificate of certified public accountant granted  
4 by the board under section 116.5 and the registration with  
5 the board as a public accountant under section 116.6, and

7 section 116.7 or 116.8 shall be renewed as determined by the  
8 board. There shall be a renewal fee, in the amount to be  
9 determined from time to time by the board. The board shall  
10 give notice by restricted certified mail, return receipt  
11 requested, to the holder of a certificate, registration, or  
12 license who has failed to renew it. If the holder fails to  
13 renew the certificate, registration, or license within thirty  
14 days of receipt of the notice, the certificate, registration,

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill allows a certificate of a certified public ac-  
20 countant, registration of a public accountant, and license  
21 of an accounting practitioner to lapse upon failure to renew  
22 after notice. Present law requires initiating a revocation  
23 proceeding. The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

24 This bill implements recommendation 383 of the governor's

AN ACT

TO CHANGE THE PROCEDURES RELATING TO FAILURE TO RENEW A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 116.20, subsection 1, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

1. The certificate of certified public accountant granted by the board under section 116.5 and the registration with the board as a public accountant under section 116.6, and the license to practice as an accounting practitioner under section 116.7 or 116.8 shall be renewed as determined by the board. There shall be a renewal fee, in the amount to be determined from time to time by the board. The board shall give notice by restricted certified mail, return receipt requested, to the holder of a certificate, registration, or license who has failed to renew it. If the holder fails to renew the certificate, registration, or license within thirty
