12 the remaining required laboratory instruction.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that after a student has completed three
15 of the six or more hours of laboratory instruction for driver
16 education consisting of street or highway driving, upon the
17 written request of the student's parent or guardian, the
18 instructor may waive the remaining required laboratory
19 instruction if the student has demonstrated to the instructor
20 an ability to properly operate a motor vehicle. The bill
21 takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

RELATING TO THE HOURS OF LABORATORY INSTRUCTION REQUIRED FOR COMPLETION OF A DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.178, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

An approved driver education course as programmed by the department of public instruction shall consist of at least thirty clock hours of classroom instruction, and six or more clock hours of laboratory instruction of which at least three clock hours shall consist of street or highway driving. After the student has completed three clock hours of street or highway driving and has demonstrated to the instructor an ability to properly operate a motor vehicle and upon written request of a parent or guardian, the instructor may waive the remaining required laboratory instruction.

Sec. 2. Section 321.178, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

Every public school district in Iowa shall offer or make available to all students residing in the school district or Iowa students attending a nonpublic school in the district an approved course in driver education. Said The courses may be offered at sites other than at the public school, including nonpublic school facilities within the public school districts. An approved course offered during the summer months, on Saturdays, after regular school hours during the regular terms or partly in one term or summer vacation period and partly in the succeeding term or summer vacation period, as the case may be, shall satisfy the requirements of this section to the same extent as an approved course offered during the regular school hours of the school term. A student
