1 Section 1. Section 356.36, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new unnumbered paragraph:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The sole remedy for violation

6 social services. A violation of a rule does not permit any
7 civil action to recover damages against the state of Iowa,

EXPLANATION

11 This bill limits the remedy for violation of a rule adopted
12 by the department of social services concerning minimum
13 standards for the regulation of jails and alternative jails,
14 to a proceeding for compliance initiated by a request to the
15 department of social services. The bill takes effect July
16 1 following its enactment.

RELATING TO THE REMEDY FOR VIOLATION OF A RULE PROVIDING A
MINIMUM STANDARD FOR THE REGULATION OF JAILS AND ALTERNATIVE
JAILS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 356.36, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The sole remedy for violation of a rule adopted pursuant to this section is by a proceeding for compliance initiated by request to the department of social services. A violation of a rule does not permit any civil action to recover damages against the state of Iowa,
