1 Section 1. Section 273.3, subsection 7, Code 1981, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 7. Be authorized to lease, subject to the approval of
4 the state board of public instruction, ~~to lease,~~ and to receive
5 by gift and operate and maintain ~~such~~ facilities and buildings
6 ~~as deemed~~ necessary to provide authorized programs and
7 services. However, a lease for less than ten years and with
8 an annual cost of less than twenty-five thousand dollars does
9 not require the approval of the state board. If a lease
10 requires approval, the state board shall not approve the
11 ~~leasing-or-renting-of-facilities-or-buildings~~ lease until
12 ~~it~~ the state board is satisfied by investigation that ~~no~~
13 public school corporations within the area do not have suitable
14 facilities available.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill permits an area education agency to lease fa-
17 cilities and buildings for less than ten years and costs
18 twenty-five thousand dollars or less per year, receive gifts,
19 and operate and maintain facilities and buildings without
20 the approval of the state board of public instruction. Present
21 law requires that the state board of public instruction approve
22 all leases for facilities and buildings for area education
23 agencies.

24 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO LEASING OF FACILITIES AND BUILDINGS, THE RECEIPT OF GIFTS, AND THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FACILITIES AND BUILDINGS BY AN AREA EDUCATION AGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 273.3, subsection 7, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

1. Be authorized to lease, subject to the approval of the state board of public instruction, ~~to lease~~ and to receive by gift and operate and maintain ~~such~~ facilities and buildings ~~as deemed~~ necessary to provide authorized programs and services. However, a lease for less than ten years and with an annual cost of less than twenty-five thousand dollars does not require the approval of the state board. If a lease requires approval, the state board shall not approve the ~~leasing-or-renting-of-facilities-or-buildings~~ lease until ~~at the state board~~ is satisfied by investigation that no
