6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill provides for the continuation of the functions  
8 and responsibilities of the energy policy council until June,  
9 1988. The legislature is directed to review the activities  
10 of the council no later than July 1, 1987. The bill also  
11 provides for the council to submit a report on an annual  
12 rather than a quarterly basis, and eliminates the require-  
13 ment that public recognition for innovative energy conservation  
14 methods be given to ten categories of individuals and  
15 organizations in each congressional district. The bill is  
16 effective July 1 following its enactment.

FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY SENATOR RAMSEY

In compliance with a written request there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House File 2373 pursuant to Joint Rule 16.

House File 2373 is an Act relating to the continuation of the activities and functions of the energy policy council. This Act also changes from a quarterly to an annual basis the requirement for a report identifying trends relating to energy supply, demand, and conservation. In addition, this Act eliminates the requirement of public recognition for various categories of innovative energy conservation.

Assumptions:

- a) The state will continue appropriations to the energy policy council at or around current levels.
- b) Current responsibilities for oversight and administration of federal energy conservation and energy assistance programs will remain within the energy policy council.

Fiscal Impact:

Under this Act no significant increase or decrease is anticipated in the amount of state funding needed to continue the energy policy council. The two changes in requirements, annual report instead of quarterly and elimination of conservation awards, will generate minimal dollar savings but will increase staff time available.

Currently the state appropriation for the energy policy council, for FY 1983, is \$413,425.

RELATING TO THE CONTINUATION OF THE ACTIVITIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE ENERGY POLICY COUNCIL, CHANGING THE DATE OF THE SUBMISSION OF THE COUNCIL'S REQUIRED REPORT, AND ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT PUBLIC RECOGNITION FOR INNOVATIVE ENERGY CONSERVATION METHODS BE GIVEN TO TEN CATEGORIES OF INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS IN EACH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 93.7, subsection 4, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

4. On at least ~~a quarterly~~ an annual basis submit to the governor and the general assembly, and to each member of the

senate and the house of representatives and the legislative council when the general assembly is not in session, a report identifying trends relating to energy supply, demand, and conservation and making recommendations to the governor and the general assembly for additional action in accordance with the report. The council shall include in its report the amount, price, and disposition of the fuel contracted for each month pursuant to subsection 9 and the name of the supplier of the fuel.

Sec. 2. Section 93.7, subsection 15, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

15. Develop a program ~~in each congressional district in the state~~ to annually give public recognition to innovative methods of energy conservation ~~developed or used by or for persons in the following categories:~~

- a--Individuals
- b--Nonprofit or other organizations
- c--Single-family residences
- d--Multiple-family residences
- e--Agriculture
- f--Commercial enterprises
- g--Industries
- h--Utilities
- i--Governments
- j--Transportation

Sec. 3. Section 93.16, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

93.16 REVIEW. The ~~second~~ first session of the ~~Sixty-ninth~~ Seventy-second General Assembly meeting in the year ~~1982~~ 1987 shall review the activities and performance of the council and shall not later than July 1, ~~1982~~ 1987 make a determination concerning the status and duties of the council.

Sec. 4. Section 93.17, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

93.17 REPEAL. Chapter 93 of the Code is repealed June  
30, ~~1993~~ 1988.
