1 Section 1. Section 107.17, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
2 1981, is amended to read as follows:

3 The state fish and game protection fund, except as otherwise
4 provided, shall consist of all moneys accruing from license
5 fees and all other sources of revenue arising under the
6 division of fish and game. Notwithstanding section 453.7,
7 subsection 2, interest or earnings on investments or time
8 deposits of the funds in the state fish and game protection
9 fund shall be credited to the state fish and game protection
10 fund.

11 EXPLANATION

12 In Acts of the Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Ses-
13 sion, chapter 12, section 6, subsection 3, the interest and
14 earnings of the funds in the state fish and game protection
15 fund were credited to that fund. This bill codifies that
16 practice and makes it permanent.

17 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE INTEREST AND EARNINGS OF THE STATE FISH AND GAME PROTECTION FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 107.17, unnumbered paragraph 7, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

The state fish and game protection fund, except as otherwise provided, shall consist of all moneys accruing from license fees and all other sources of revenue arising under the division of fish and game. Notwithstanding section 453.7, subsection 2, interest or earnings on investments or time
