14 EXPLANATION

In compliance with a written request received March 11, 19 82, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House File 2441 pursuant to Joint Rule 16. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

H.F. 2441, An Act requiring the department of social services to study and recommend a proposal relating to elderly independent group homes.

The bill requires the department of social services to study and recommend a proposal relating to elderly independent group homes to the general assembly by January 15, 1983.

The study would require a survey of relevant literature, a market survey to determine the needs and requirements of Iowa's target population, and development of standards for independent group living arrangements for the elderly.

The department of social services estimates that the study would cost between \$6,000 and \$12,000. This range is based on the department of social services either contracting for the full study or a portion of the study.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter 217, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new section:
