3 "The chief judge of each judicial district shall
4 provide by order for the designation of two or more
5 judicial magistrates in each of those counties having
6 two or more judicial magistrates, other than those
7 counties having two judicial magistrates by virtue
8 of section 602.58, who shall be available at times
9 prescribed by the chief judge to perform marriage
10 ceremonies upon request. The clerk of court shall
11 post a copy of the order for public view in the clerk's
12 office."
