13 EXPLANATION

14 Current law requires an applicant for an instruction or
15 temporary driver's permit or operator's, chauffeur's, or
16 motorized bicycle license to list whether any such license
17 of the applicant has ever been revoked or suspended or an
18 application for a license has ever been refused. This bill
19 limits the inquiry to the past five years. The bill will
20 take effect July 1 following its enactment.

RELATING TO THE CONTENTS OF A PERMIT OR LICENSE APPLICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.183, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

321.183 CONTENTS OF APPLICATION. Every said application shall state the full name, date of birth, sex, and residence address of the applicant, and briefly describe the applicant, and shall state whether the applicant has ~~theretofore~~ previously been licensed as an operator or chauffeur, and, if so, when and by what state or country, and whether any such license has ever been suspended or revoked within the past six years, or whether an application has ever been refused
