2 1981, is amended to read as follows:

3 The director may issue temporary written authorization
4 to carriers for vehicles acquired by a fleet owner and added
5 to the fleet owner's prorated fleet after the beginning of
6 the registration year. The temporary authority shall permit
7 the operation of a commercial vehicle until permanent
8 identification is issued, except that the temporary authority
9 shall expire after ~~thirty~~ forty-five days.

10 EXPLANATION

11 The bill increases the time period for which a temporary
12 authority for a commercial vehicle is valid from 30 to 45
13 days. The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 326.11, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

The director may issue temporary written authorization to carriers for vehicles acquired by a fleet owner and added to the fleet owner's prorated fleet after the beginning of the registration year. The temporary authority shall permit the operation of a commercial vehicle until permanent
