A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing a hunter safety education program and
2 subjecting violators to a penalty, to be effective July 1,
3 1983.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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772

1 Section 1. Chapter 110, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. HUNTER SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM--REQUIREMENT
4 FOR LICENSE.

5 1. A hunting license shall not be issued to a person born
6 after January 1, 1967 by the commission, a county recorder,
7 or a depository authorized to issue hunting licenses, unless
8 the person exhibits a certificate showing satisfactory
9 completion of a hunter safety education course approved by
10 the commission. A certificate of completion from an approved
11 hunter safety education course shall not be issued to any
12 person under twelve years of age. A certificate of completion
13 from an approved hunter safety education course issued in
14 this state since 1960, by another state, or by a province
15 of Canada is valid for the requirements of this section.

16 2. A certificate of completion shall not be issued to
17 a person who has not satisfactorily completed a minimum of
18 eight hours of training in an approved hunter safety education
19 course.

20 3. The commission shall provide a manual on hunter safety
21 education which shall be used by all instructors and persons
22 receiving hunter safety education training in this state.

23 4. The commission shall provide for the certification
24 of persons who wish to become hunter safety instructors.
25 A person shall not act as an instructor in hunter safety
26 education as provided in this section without first obtaining
27 an instructor's certificate from the commission.

28 5. A public or private school or organization approved
29 by the commission may cooperate with the commission in
30 providing a course in hunter safety education as provided
31 in this section.

32 6. A hunting license obtained under this section by a
33 person who gave false information or presented a fraudulent
34 certificate of completion shall be revoked and a new hunting
35 license shall not be issued for at least two years from the

1 date of conviction. The license revocation is in addition
2 to the penalty provided in section 110.42.

3 7. The state conservation commission shall adopt rules
4 in accordance with chapter 17A as necessary to carry out the
5 administration of this section.

6 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1983.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides that a person born after January 1,
9 1967 must complete a hunter safety instruction course before
10 obtaining a hunting license. A certificate of completion
11 shall not be issued to any person under twelve years of age.
12 The bill authorizes public or private schools or organizations
13 approved by the commission to provide an approved course of
14 instruction. Instructors must also be certified by the state
15 conservation commission.

16 The bill also provides for the revocation of a hunting
17 license obtained by a fraudulent practice. Violators are
18 also subject to punishment as a simple misdemeanor. This
19 bill takes effect July 1, 1983.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter 110, Code 1981, is amended by adding
the following new section:

NEW SECTION. HUNTER SAFETY AND ETHICS EDUCATION PROGRAM-
-REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSE.

1. A hunting license shall not be issued to a person born
after January 1, 1967 by the commission, a county recorder,
or a depository authorized to issue hunting licenses, unless
the person exhibits a certificate showing satisfactory
completion of a hunter safety and ethics education course
approved by the commission. A certificate of completion from
an approved hunter safety education course shall not be issued
to any person under twelve years of age. A certificate of

state.

4. The commission shall provide for the certification
of persons who wish to become hunter safety and ethics
instructors. A person shall not act as an instructor in
hunter safety and ethics education as provided in this section
without first obtaining an instructor's certificate from the
commission.

5. An officer of the commission or a certified instructor
may issue a certificate to a person who has not completed
the hunter safety and ethics education course but has
demonstrated to that officer or instructor a satisfactory
knowledge of hunter safety and ethics.

6. A public or private school or organization approved
by the commission may cooperate with the commission in
providing a course in hunter safety and ethics education as
provided in this section.

7. A hunting license obtained under this section by a
person who gave false information or presented a fraudulent
certificate of completion shall be revoked and a new hunting
license shall not be issued for at least two years from the
date of conviction.
