32 The bill delays for one year from July 1, 1981 to July
33 1, 1982 the requirement for successful completion of a
34 motorcycle education course or a motorized bicycle education
35 course prior to the issuance of certain motor vehicle
36 operators' licenses. The bill takes effect July 1, 1981.

AN ACT

TO DELAY FOR SIX MONTHS FROM JULY 1, 1981 TO JANUARY 1, 1982 THE REQUIREMENT FOR SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A MOTORCYCLE EDUCATION COURSE OR A MOTORIZED BICYCLE EDUCATION COURSE PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS' LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.189, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

After ~~July~~ January 1, 1981 ~~1982~~, a person under the age of eighteen applying for a motor vehicle license valid for the operation of a motorcycle shall be required to successfully complete a motorcycle education course approved and established by the department of public instruction or successfully complete an approved motorcycle education course at a private or commercial driver education school licensed by the department. A public school district ~~may~~ shall charge a student a fee which shall not exceed the actual cost of instruction.

Sec. 2. Section 321.189, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

a. The department may issue a motorized bicycle license to a person fourteen years of age or older who has passed a vision test and a written examination on the rules of the road. After ~~July~~ January 1, 1981 ~~1982~~, persons under the age of sixteen applying for a motorized bicycle license shall also be required to successfully complete a motorized bicycle education course approved and established by the department of public instruction or successfully complete an approved motorized bicycle education course at a private or commercial driver education school licensed by the department. A public

school district ~~may~~ shall charge a student a fee which shall not exceed the actual cost of instruction. A motorized bicycle license entitles the licensee to operate a motorized bicycle upon the highway while having the license in the licensee's immediate possession. The license is valid for a period of two years, subject to termination or cancellation as provided in this section.
