13 EXPLANATION

14 The provision in 79.1 which provides for charging payroll
15 for overlapping pay periods to the latter fiscal year if half
16 or more of the pay period falls in that year is replaced by
17 a requirement that the payroll be charged to the fiscal year
18 in which it is paid. A provision in the 1979 salary
19 appropriation bill which set beginning and ending dates for
20 allocation of expenditures from July 1, 1979 through July
21 10, 1981 is repealed, as well as the requirement for a payroll
22 accrual account. The bill takes effect upon publication.

as follows:

budgets for state departments, the state comptroller shall
compute an amount for each fiscal year sufficient to provide
