AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE REVERSION OF ALL UNENCUMBERED BALANCES  
IN THE DEPRECIATION FUND OF THE STATE VEHICLE DISPATCHER  
AS OF NOVEMBER 30, 1980 TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 18.120, any moneys appropriated which have been credited to the depreciation fund of the motor vehicle dispatcher by a department or agency and which are unencumbered balances to the department or agency as of November 30, 1980 shall revert to the general fund of the state.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect from and after its publication in the Fort Madison Daily Democrat, a newspaper published in Fort Madison, Iowa.
