1 Section 1. Chapter 280A, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. PAYMENT OF EXPENSES. The board of directors
4 of a merged area shall audit and allow all just claims against
5 the area school and an order shall not be drawn upon the
6 treasury until the claim has been audited and allowed.
7 However, the board of directors, by resolution, may authorize
8 the secretary of the board, when the board is not in session,
9 to issue payments for salaries pursuant to the terms of a
10 written contract and to issue payments upon the receipt of
11 verification filed with the secretary for expenses for freight;
12 drayage; express; postage; printing; utilities including
13 electricity, water, waste collection, heating, air
14 conditioning, telephone, and telegraph charges; expenses
15 involving auxiliary, agency, and scholarship and loan accounts;
16 and refunds to students for tuition and fees. The secretary
17 shall either deliver in person or mail the payments to the
18 payees. A payment shall be made payable only to the person
19 performing the service or furnishing the supplies for which
20 the payment is issued. Payments issued prior to audit and
21 allowance by the board shall be allowed by the board at the
22 first meeting held after the issuance and shall be entered
23 in the minutes of the meeting.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill allows the boards of merged areas to authorize
26 the secretary of the board to pay certain stated expenditures
27 in advance of their specific allowance by the board. The
28 board would then allow the payments at its next meeting.
29 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO PAYMENT OF EXPENSES BY BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF MERGED AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter 280A, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. PAYMENT OF EXPENSES. The board of directors of a merged area shall audit and allow all just claims against the area school and an order shall not be drawn upon the treasury until the claim has been audited and allowed. However, the board of directors, by resolution, may authorize the secretary of the board, when the board is not in session, to issue payments for salaries pursuant to the terms of a written contract and to issue payments upon the receipt of verification filed with the secretary for expenses for freight; drayage; express; postage; printing; utilities including electricity, water, waste collection, heating, air conditioning, telephone, and telegraph charges; expenses involving auxiliary, agency, and scholarship and loan accounts; and refunds to students for tuition and fees. The secretary shall either deliver in person or mail the payments to the payees. A payment shall be made payable only to the person performing the service or furnishing the supplies for which the payment is issued. Payments issued prior to audit and allowance by the board shall be allowed by the board at the
