 7 324.65, and 324.68 and the agreement shall govern  
 8 carriers covered by the agreement. Copies of the  
 9 agreement shall be filed with the secretary of the  
 10 senate and the chief clerk of the house."

1 Section 1. Chapter 324, division III, Code 1981, is amended  
2 by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. The director of transportation may, subject  
4 to the approval of the transportation commission, enter into  
5 motor fuel tax agreements on behalf of this state with  
6 authorized representatives of other states. The director  
7 of transportation may enter into and the state department  
8 of transportation may become a member of a motor fuel tax  
9 agreement for the collection and refund of interstate motor  
10 fuel tax. The director of transportation may adopt rules  
11 pursuant to chapter 17A to implement the agreement for the  
12 collection and refund of interstate motor fuel tax.

13 Where sections 324.57, 324.58, 324.65, and 324.68 conflict  
14 with the agreement, the provisions of the agreement shall  
15 govern carriers covered by the agreement.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The bill allows Iowa to enter into reciprocal agreements  
18 with other states for reporting, paying, and refunding  
19 interstate motor fuel tax. The bill takes effect July 1  
20 following enactment.

SENATE FILE 2201

AN ACT

TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR THE COLLECTION AND REFUNDING OF INTER-STATE MOTOR FUEL TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter 324, division III, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. The director of transportation may, subject to the approval of the transportation commission, enter into motor fuel tax agreements on behalf of this state with authorized representatives of other states. The director of transportation may enter into and the state department of transportation may become a member of a motor fuel tax agreement for the collection and refund of interstate motor fuel tax. The director of transportation may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to implement the agreement for the collection and refund of interstate motor fuel tax.

The department may enter into an agreement for the collection and refund of interstate motor fuel tax which conflicts with sections 324.57, 324.58, 324.65, and 324.68 and the agreement shall govern carriers covered by the
