In compliance with a written request received April 22, 1982, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 2298 pursuant to Joint Rule 16. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2298 is a bill to legalize action of the Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission allowing its employees to be optional members of the IPERS prior to October 1, 1981.

The bill legalizes actions already taken by the Planning Commission. The bill has no state fiscal impact.

TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE SOUTHEAST IOWA REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION ALLOWING ITS EMPLOYEES TO BE OPTIONAL MEMBERS OF THE IOWA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, 1981, EFFECTIVE UPON PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, prior to October 1, 1981, the directors of the southeast Iowa regional planning commission believed that its employees could elect whether to be members of the Iowa public employees' retirement system; and

WHEREAS, section 97B.41, subsection 3, defines regional planning commissions created under chapter 473A as being "employers" under chapter 97B; and

WHEREAS, the eligible employees at the southeast Iowa regional planning commission should under chapter 97B be members of the Iowa public employees' retirement system; and

WHEREAS, on and after October 1, 1981, the director of the southeast Iowa regional planning commission requires its eligible employees to be members of the Iowa public employees' retirement system; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That the action of the southeast Iowa regional planning commission prior to October 1, 1981, of allowing its employees to elect whether to be members of the Iowa public employees' retirement system is validated, legalized, and confirmed.
