1 Section 1. Section 642.2, subsection 4, Code 1981, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 4. Service upon the garnishee shall be made by serving
4 an original notice with a copy of the judgment against the
5 defendant, and with a copy of the questions specified in
6 section 642.5, by certified mail or by personal service upon
7 the attorney general, county attorney, city attorney, secretary
8 of the school district, or ~~either~~ legal counsel of the
9 appropriate governmental unit. The garnishee shall be required
10 to answer within thirty days following receipt of the notice.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill provides that notice of garnishment for an
13 employee of a school district be served on the secretary of
14 the school district rather than the school district's legal
15 counsel. The bill takes effect on July 1 following its
16 enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PERSON TO WHOM NOTICE OF GARNISHMENT IS SERVED IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 642.2, subsection 4, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

4. Service upon the garnishee shall be made by serving an original notice with a copy of the judgment against the defendant, and with a copy of the questions specified in section 642.5, by certified mail or by personal service upon the attorney general, county attorney, city attorney, secretary
