2 conservation commission and providing a penalty.

1 Section 1. Chapter 110, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. A nonresident shall not obtain a resident
4 license by falsely claiming residency in the state. The use
5 of a license by a person other than the person to whom the
6 license is issued is unlawful and shall nullify the license.
7 A resident or nonresident who violates this section is guilty
8 of a simple misdemeanor.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill prohibits a nonresident from obtaining a legal
11 resident license issued by the state conservation commission
12 and prohibits a person from using a license issued to another
13 person by the commission.

14 The bill provides a penalty of a simple misdemeanor for
15 the violation of the two prohibitions.

16 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter 110, Code 1981, is amended by adding
the following new section:

NEW SECTION. A nonresident shall not obtain a resident
