3 342.3 QUARTERLY REPORTS AND PAYMENTS. Each of ~~such~~ the
4 county officers shall make ~~itemized-and-verified~~ reports
5 quarterly to the board of supervisors showing ~~in-detail~~, by
6 type, the fees collected during the preceding quarter. Each
7 ~~such~~ officer shall quarterly pay into the county treasury
8 all fees collected during the preceding quarter, take duplicate
9 receipts ~~therefor~~ for the fees and file one of ~~such~~ the
10 receipts in the office of the auditor. Each ~~such~~ officer
11 shall also enter upon the officer's fee book ~~of-his-office~~
12 the date and amount of each payment into the county treasury.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that the quarterly fee reports to the
15 board of supervisors show the fees collected, by type, and
16 that less detail is necessary in the reports. This bill is
17 requested by the auditor of state.

18 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
