1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
2 of the State of Iowa is proposed:

3 Section 7, subdivision 2 entitled "School Funds and School
4 Lands", of Article IX of the Constitution of the State of
5 Iowa is repealed.

6 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the
7 Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the general
8 assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members
9 of the general assembly and the secretary of state is directed
10 to cause it to be published for three consecutive months
11 before the date of that election as provided by law.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This amendment strikes the section of the Iowa Constitution
14 that requires money subject to the support and maintenance
15 of common schools, which the Iowa Supreme Court has interpreted
16 as interest from the permanent school fund, to be distributed
17 to school districts on the basis of their population of persons
18 between five and twenty-one years of age.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
of the State of Iowa is proposed:

Section 7, subdivision 2 entitled "School Funds and School
Lands", of Article IX of the Constitution of the State of
Iowa is repealed.

Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the
Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the general
assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members
of the general assembly and the secretary of state is directed
