FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY REPRESENTATIVE OLLIE

In compliance with a written request received January 18, 1983, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House File 132 pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 132 is an Act which removes the requirement that the costs of special education programs and services, media services, and educational programs and services provided by an area education agency and requested by the local boards of education do not exceed the amount of money available through the area education agency under the chapters relating to the education of children requiring special education and the school foundation program.

There will be little change on a state-wide average basis. It may increase expenditures by a particular district for a particular student's placement. This amount will have to be paid from special education instructional balances. If such costs placed a district in a deficit position, relief from the School Budget Review Committee could be sought.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill removes the requirement that the costs of special

Section 1. Section 273.3, subsection 5, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

5. Be authorized, subject to rules and regulations of the state board of public instruction, to provide directly or by contractual arrangement with public or private agencies for special education programs and services, media services, and educational programs and services requested by the local boards of education as provided in this chapter, including but not limited to contracts for the area education agency to provide programs or services to the local school districts and contracts for local school districts, other educational agencies, and public and private agencies to provide programs and services to the local school districts in the area education agency in lieu of the area education agency providing such the services.
