1 Section 1. Section 281.2, subsection 1, Code 1983, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. "Children requiring special education" means persons
4 under twenty-one years of age, including children under five
5 years of age, who are handicapped in obtaining an education
6 because of physical, mental, ~~emotional~~, communication or
7 learning disabilities or who are ~~chronically-disruptive~~
8 behaviorally disordered, as defined by the rules of the
9 department of public instruction.

10 Sec. 2. Section 281.9, subsection 1, paragraph d, Code
11 1983, is amended to read as follows:

12 d. Children requiring special education who are severely
13 handicapped or who have multiple handicaps, ~~or who are~~
14 ~~chronically-disruptive~~, are assigned to a weighting of four
15 and four-tenths for the school year commencing July 1, 1975.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill replaces the special education categories of
18 "emotional disabilities" and "chronically disruptive" with
19 a category of "behavioral disorders".

20 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONSOLIDATION OF CERTAIN SPECIAL EDUCATION CATEGORIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 281.2, subsection 1, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

1. "Children requiring special education" means persons under twenty-one years of age, including children under five years of age, who are handicapped in obtaining an education because of physical, mental, ~~emotional~~, communication or learning disabilities or who are ~~chronically-disruptive~~ behaviorally disordered, as defined by the rules of the department of public instruction.
