26 other qualified organizations and applicants for the purpose  
27 of having the qualified organizations conduct the games of  
28 skill, games of chance, and raffles in lieu of the political  
29 party or party organization. This bill takes effect July  
30 1 following enactment.

PROVIDING THAT A POLITICAL PARTY OR CANDIDATE COMMITTEE OR PARTY ORGANIZATION IS A QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING GAMES OF SKILL, GAMES OF CHANCE, AND RAFFLES AND PROVIDING THAT A POLITICAL PARTY OR PARTY ORGANIZATION MAY CONTRACT WITH ANOTHER QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION TO CONDUCT THE GAMES OF SKILL, GAMES OF CHANCE, OR RAFFLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 99B.7, subsection 1, paragraph n, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

m. The person or organization conducting the game can show to the satisfaction of the department that it the person or organization is eligible for exemption from federal income taxation under either section 501(c)(3), 501(c)(5), 501(c)(6), 501(c)(10) or 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code, as defined in section 422.4. However, this paragraph does not apply to a political party as defined in section 43.2 or to a nonparty political organization that has qualified to place a candidate as its nominee for statewide office pursuant to chapter 44, or to a candidate committee as defined in section 56.2.

Sec. 2. Section 99B.7, Code 1983, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 5. A political party or a political party organization is a qualified organization within the meaning of this chapter. Political parties or party organizations may contract with other qualified organizations to conduct the games of skill, games of chance, and raffles which may lawfully be conducted by the political party or party

organization. A licensed qualified organization may promote the games of skill, games of chance, and raffles which it may lawfully conduct.
