A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide for the transportation commission to submit
2 the results of the quadrennial need study to the general
3 assembly by January 1 of the year in which the quadrennial
4 need study becomes effective.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 307A.2, subsection 14, Code 1983, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 14. For the four-year period beginning July 1, 1979, and
4 for each subsequent four-year period, prepare, adopt and cause
5 to be published the results of a study of all roads and streets
6 in the state. The study shall be so designed to investigate
7 present deficiencies and future twenty-year maintenance and
8 construction needs of the roads and the ability of each
9 applicable authority to meet the needs for the planning,
10 construction, repair and maintenance of roads within their

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EXPLANATION

24 The bill provides a date, six months in advance of the

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO SUBMIT THE RESULTS OF THE QUADRENNIAL NEED STUDY TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY JANUARY 1 OF THE YEAR IN WHICH THE QUADRENNIAL NEED STUDY BECOMES EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 307A.2, subsection 14, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

14. For the four-year period beginning July 1, 1979, and for each subsequent four-year period, prepare, adopt and cause to be published the results of a study of all roads and streets in the state.
