3 2.51 VISITATIONS. The legislative fiscal committee, with
4 the approval of the legislative council, may direct a
5 subcommittee, which shall be composed of the chairpersons
6 and minority party ranking members of the appropriate
7 subcommittees of the committees on budget of the senate and
8 the house of representatives and the chairpersons of the
9 appropriate standing committees of the general assembly, to
10 visit the offices and facilities of any state office,
11 department, agency, board, bureau, or commission to review
12 programs authorized by the general assembly and the
13 administration of the programs. When the legislative fiscal
14 committee visits the offices and facilities of any state
15 office, department, agency, board, bureau, or commission to
16 review programs authorized by the general assembly and the
17 administration of the programs, there shall be included the
18 chairpersons and minority party ranking members of the
19 appropriate subcommittees of the committees on budget of the
20 senate and the house of representatives. The legislative
21 council may appoint a member of the subcommittee or standing
22 committee to serve in that subcommittee's or standing
23 committee's chairperson's or ranking minority party member's
24 place on the legislative fiscal visitation committee or
25 subcommittee if that person will be absent. The subcommittee
26 and the legislative fiscal committee shall be provided with
27 information by the legislative fiscal bureau concerning
28 budgets, programs, and legislation authorizing programs prior
29 to any visitation. Members of a committee shall be compensated
30 pursuant to section 2.10, subsection 6. The subcommittee
31 shall make reports and recommendations as required by the
32 legislative fiscal committee.

33 EXPLANATION

34 This bill allows the legislative council to appoint a
35 replacement for a chairperson or minority ranking member who
36 serves on a visitation subcommittee and will be absent.

RELATING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF LEGISLATIVE VISITATION COMMITTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 2.51, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

2.51 VISITATIONS. The legislative fiscal committee, with the approval of the legislative council, may direct a subcommittee, which shall be composed of the chairpersons and minority party ranking members of the appropriate subcommittees of the committees on budget of the senate and the house of representatives and the chairpersons of the appropriate standing committees of the general assembly, to visit the offices and facilities of any state office, department, agency, board, bureau, or commission to review programs authorized by the general assembly and the administration of the programs. When the legislative fiscal committee visits the offices and facilities of any state office, department, agency, board, bureau, or commission to review programs authorized by the general assembly and the administration of the programs, there shall be included the chairpersons and minority party ranking members of the appropriate subcommittees of the committees on budget of the senate and the house of representatives. The legislative council may appoint a member of the subcommittee or standing committee to serve in place of that subcommittee's or standing committee's chairperson or minority party ranking member on the legislative fiscal visitation committee or subcommittee if that person will be absent. The subcommittee and the legislative fiscal committee shall be provided with information by the legislative fiscal bureau concerning budgets, programs,

and legislation authorizing programs prior to any visitation. Members of a committee shall be compensated pursuant to section 2.10, subsection 6. The subcommittee shall make reports and recommendations as required by the legislative fiscal committee.
