21 with the application a schedule of fees to be charged for
22 services rendered to patrons, which schedule shall not be
23 changed during the term of license without consent being first
24 given by the commission.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill increases the amount of the surety bond which
27 is to be submitted to and approved by the labor commissioner
28 when applying for an employment agency license from two
29 thousand dollars to twenty thousand dollars. The bill takes
30 effect July 1 following its enactment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 95.2, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

Application for ~~such~~ a license shall be made in writing to the commission provided in section 95.1. It shall contain the name of the applicant, and if ~~the~~ applicant ~~be~~ is a firm, the names of the members, and if it ~~be~~ is a corporation, the names of the officers ~~thereof~~; and the name, number and address of the building and place where the employment agency is to be conducted. It shall be accompanied by the affidavits of at least two reputable citizens of the state in no way connected with ~~the~~ applicant, certifying to the good moral character and reliability of the applicant, or, if a firm or corporation of each of the members or officers ~~thereof~~, and that the applicant is a citizen of the United States, if a natural person; also a surety company bond in the sum of ~~two~~ twenty thousand dollars when an employee is required to contribute to the payment of fees to be approved by the labor commissioner and conditioned to pay any damages that may accrue to any person ~~or persons~~ because of any a wrongful act, or violation of law, on the part of ~~the~~ applicant in the conduct of ~~said~~ the business.
