1 Section 1. Section 331.604, Code 1983, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 331.604 GENERAL RECORDING AND FILING FEE. Except as
4 otherwise provided by state law or section 331.605, the
5 recorder shall collect a fee of ~~three~~ five dollars for each
6 page or fraction of a page of an instrument which is filed
7 or recorded in the recorder's office.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill increases the filing or recording fee from three
10 dollars to five dollars per page or fraction of a page of
11 an instrument which is recorded at the county recorder's
12 office.

13 This bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
