In compliance with a written request received January 30, 1984, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HOUSE FILE 2265 pursuant to Joint Rule 17. HF 2265

House File 2265 is an Act which permits a teacher at the Iowa braille and sight-saving school or the Iowa school for the deaf to be eligible for reimbursement for the guaranteed student loan program and to be eligible for the Iowa science and mathematics loan program repayment cancellation.

FISCAL IMPACT: This would not increase any state funds. The loan amounts are standing limiteds and are not changed in this bill.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill permits a teacher at the Iowa braille and sight-  
21 saving school or the Iowa school for the deaf to be eligible  
22 for reimbursement for the guaranteed student loan program  
23 after meeting other criteria and to be eligible for the Iowa  
24 science and mathematics loan program repayment cancellation  
25 if certain criteria are met.

26 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 261.45, subsection 1, Code Supplement 1983, is amended to read as follows:

1. Is a teacher employed on a full-time basis under sections 279.13 through 279.19 in a school district in this state or, is a teacher in an approved nonpublic school in this state, or is a certified teacher at the Iowa braille and sight-saving school or the Iowa school for the deaf.

Sec. 2. Section 261.54, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code Supplement 1983, is amended to read as follows:

Repayment of the loan shall begin one year after the teacher completes the educational program for which tuition and fees are received. If a teacher submits evidence to the commission that the teacher was employed as a teacher of one or more science or mathematics courses or as an elementary teacher teaching science and mathematics in a public school district or nonpublic school in this state or at the Iowa braille and
