REQUESTED BY REPRESENTATIVE COCHRAN

In compliance with a written request received February 15, 1984, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HOUSE FILE 2323 pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the General Assembly upon request.

House File 2323 extends the period from 20 to 30 days in which a person is allowed to pay a special assessment for a drainage district without paying interest.

There would be no fiscal effect on state revenues. The effect on drainage district funds is expected to be very small.

3 455.63 PAYMENT BEFORE BONDS OR CERTIFICATES ISSUED. All
4 assessments for benefits, as corrected and approved by the
5 board, shall be levied at one time against the property
6 benefited, and when levied and certified by the board, shall
7 be are payable at the office of the county treasurer. Each

11 and before any warrants against assessments, improvement

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides that a person who has received a special
17 assessment from a drainage district, may pay the assessment
18 in full without interest within thirty days. This bill
19 increases the current time limit by ten days and it also
20 coincides with the thirty-day period during which a person
21 may decide whether to pay an assessment in full or by
22 installments.

23 This bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
