1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 905.11 BIENNIAL PLAN. The
2 department of social services shall prepare a biennial plan
3 relating to the management of the community-based corrections
4 programs and services.

5 The plan shall include:

6 1. Goals, objectives, operations, and funding allocations
7 for programs and projects to accomplish the requirements of
8 this chapter and the orderly development of the community-
9 based corrections programs and services.

10 2. The plans for coordination with the state agencies

14 The plan shall be prepared and submitted by the department
15 of social services to the council on social services. The
16 council shall submit the plan to the governor and the general

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill requires the department of social services to
20 prepare and the council on social services to submit a biennial
21 plan relating to the management of the community-based
22 corrections programs and services.

24 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

AN ACT

REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO PREPARE AND THE COUNCIL ON SOCIAL SERVICES TO SUBMIT A BIENNIAL PLAN RELATING TO THE MANAGEMENT OF THE COMMUNITY-BASED CORRECTIONS PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 905.11 BIENNIAL PLAN. The department of social services shall prepare a biennial plan relating to the management of the community-based corrections programs and services.

The plan shall include:

1. Goals, objectives, operations, and funding allocations for programs and projects to accomplish the requirements of this chapter and the orderly development of the community-based corrections programs and services.

2. The plans for coordination with the state agencies responsible for substance abuse services, mental health services, employment programs and other programs needed to improve the availability of services.

The plan shall be prepared and submitted by the department of social services to the council on social services. The
