A BILL FOR

1 An Act increasing the limit on the tax rate that may be

1 Section 1. Section 298.7, Code 1983, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 298.7 CONTRACT FOR USE OF LIBRARY. The board of directors
4 of ~~any~~ a school corporation in which there is no free public
5 library may contract with ~~any~~ a free public library for the
6 free use of ~~such~~ the library by the residents of ~~such~~ the
7 school district, and pay ~~such~~ the library the amount agreed

19 EXPLANATION

20 The bill provides that the board of directors of a school
21 corporation may levy up to 20 cents per \$1,000 of assessed
22 value of taxable property of a school district to raise
23 revenues to pay for the use of a free public library by the
24 residents of the school district as agreed to in a contract
25 between the free public library and the school corporation.
26 Present law limits the rate that may be levied to six and
27 three-fourths cents per \$1,000 dollars of assessed value of
28 the taxable property of the school district.

29 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

AN ACT

INCREASING THE LIMIT ON THE TAX RATE THAT MAY BE CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A SCHOOL CORPORATION TO BE LEVIED ON TAXABLE PROPERTY IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE USE OF A FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY BY RESIDENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 298.7, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

298.7 CONTRACT FOR USE OF LIBRARY. The board of directors of ~~any~~ a school corporation in which there is no free public library may contract with ~~any a~~ free public library for the free use of ~~such the~~ library by the residents of ~~such the~~ school district, and pay ~~such the~~ library the amount agreed ~~therefor upon for the use of the~~ library as provided by law. During the existence of ~~such the~~ contract, the board shall certify annually a tax sufficient to pay ~~such the~~ library the consideration agreed upon, not exceeding ~~six-and-three-fourths~~ twenty cents per thousand dollars of assessed value of the taxable property of ~~such the~~ district. During the existence of ~~such the~~ contract, the school corporation ~~shall~~ be relieved from the requirement that the school treasurer withhold funds for library purposes.
