20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that school boards which receive a
22 license to conduct gambling activities could authorize gambling
23 activities by school groups in their districts.

24 The bill also provides that a license may be issued to
25 the board of directors of a public school. The board may
26 apply for the license on a short form application provided
27 by the department. This bill takes effect July 1 following
28 enactment.

FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY REPRESENTATIVE FEY

In compliance with a written request received March 2, 1983, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House File 317 pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 317 is an Act which provides that school boards may receive a license to conduct gambling activities by school groups in their district. The bill also provides that a license may be issued to the board of directors of a public school. The board may apply for the license on a short form application provided by the department.

The impact of this Act is basically a change in administrative procedure. A very small state cost might be incurred in developing the short form to be used for license application.

RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING GAMBLING ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 99B.7, subsection 2, paragraph c, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

The board of directors of a school district may authorize that public schools within that district, and the policymaking body of a nonpublic school, may authorize that games of skill, games of chance, bingo and raffles may be held at bona fide school functions, such as carnivals, fall festivals, bazaars and similar events. Each school shall obtain a license pursuant to this section prior to permitting such the games or activities on the premises. However, the board of directors of a public school district may also be issued a license under this section. However, a board of directors of a public school shall not spend or authorize the expenditure of public funds for the purpose of purchasing a license. The department shall provide by rule a short form application for a license issued to a board of directors. Upon written approval by the board of directors, the license may be used by any school group or parent support group in the district to conduct activities authorized by this section.
