1 Section 1. Section 331.422, subsection 18, Code 1983,  
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 18. For a local, nonprofit historical society organized  
4 under chapter 504 or 504A or a city-owned historical project,  
5 not to exceed three cents per thousand dollars to be used  
6 to preserve and disseminate a knowledge of the history of  
7 the area to the general public, including but not limited  
8 to collecting and preserving historical materials, artifacts,  
9 places, and structures of the area, including repairing and  
10 maintaining buildings; maintaining a historical library and  
11 collections, including the construction, repair and maintenance  
12 of facilities necessary for exhibits and displays; conducting  
13 historical studies and researches; issuing publications; and  
14 providing public lectures of historical interest. The tax  
15 collected under this subsection shall not exceed five thousand  
16 dollars in a county with a population of less than thirty-  
17 five thousand, fifteen thousand dollars in a county with a  
18 population of thirty-five thousand or more but less than one  
19 hundred thousand, or ~~twenty-five~~ fifty thousand dollars in  
20 a county with a population of one hundred thousand or more.  
21 If there are two or more nonprofit historical societies or  
22 city-owned projects in the county, the board shall apportion  
23 the funds available under this subsection as it determines.  
24 The board shall require the historical society or city-owned  
25 project to submit to it a proposed budget including the amount  
26 of available funds and estimated expenditures, as a  
27 prerequisite to receiving funds under this subsection. A  
28 local historical society or city-owned project receiving funds  
29 under this subsection shall present to the board an annual  
30 report describing in detail its use of the funds received.

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill provides that city-owned historical projects  
33 are eligible for funding from the county board of supervisors  
34 under the tax levy for local, nonprofit historical society  
35 projects. The bill also increases the total dollar amount

1 which may be expended annually in counties having a population  
2 of one hundred thousand or more from twenty-five thousand  
3 dollars to fifty thousand dollars if the tax rate will generate  
4 that amount. The maximum tax rate remains unchanged.

5 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

HOUSE FILE 456  
FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY REPRESENTATIVE RUNNING

In compliance with a written request received March 9, 1983, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House File 456 pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 456 provides that city-owned historical projects are eligible for funding from the county board of supervisors under the tax levy for local, nonprofit historical society projects. The bill also increases the total dollar amount which may be expended annually in counties having a population of one hundred thousand or more from twenty-five thousand dollars to fifty thousand dollars if the tax rate will generate that amount. The maximum tax rate remains unchanged.

FISCAL IMPACT: There would be no impact on the General Fund. This bill would permit five counties to levy a tax of \$50,000 each for the support of local and municipal historical activities. Eighty-two counties would be able to raise \$15,000 each and twelve counties could each raise \$5,000. (1340H, 83-361, KMM)
