21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill adds to the definition of conservation farm
23 equipment cultivator and tillage equipment that can be used
24 for reduced tillage or no-till planting of row crops. It
25 also removes the twenty-five thousand dollar limitation on
26 loans that an owner or operator may receive in any one year
27 and replaces it with a single maximum total of one hundred
28 twenty-five thousand dollars for permanent soil and water
29 conservation practices and one hundred twenty-five thousand
30 dollars for conservation farm equipment.

31 This bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

RELATING TO THE AMOUNT OF MONEY AN INDIVIDUAL FARMER MAY BE
LOANED UNDER THE SOIL CONSERVATION LOAN PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 175.2, subsection 18, Code 1983, is
amended to read as follows:

18. "Conservation farm equipment" means the specialized
planters, cultivators, and tillage equipment used for reduced
tillage or no-till planting of row crops.

Sec. 2. Section 175.34, subsection 2, paragraph d, Code
1983, is amended to read as follows:

d. The amount of financing that may be provided under
the soil conservation loan program shall not exceed the cost
of implementing the permanent soil and water conservation
practice or of acquiring the conservation farm equipment which
the owner or operator is seeking to implement or acquire less
any amounts the owner or operator will receive in public cost-
sharing funds under chapter 467A or other provisions of state
or federal law for ~~such~~ the implementation or acquisition.
However, the maximum amount of loans that an owner or operator
may receive ~~in one year~~ pursuant to this program shall not
exceed ~~twenty-five~~ fifty thousand dollars for permanent soil
