25 This bill allows a city to accept and disburse federal
26 funds for economic development projects which may include
27 grants to private enterprise for the purchase or improvement
28 of residential, commercial, and industrial land or buildings.
29 It also includes use of federal assistance for privately
30 sponsored projects, within the city's urban renewal authority
31 and upon a finding of public purpose. The bill is effective

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE ACCEPTANCE AND USE BY CITIES OF FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 364.18 FEDERAL AID. Subject to applicable state or federal regulations in effect at the time of the city action, a city may accept contributions, grants, or other financial assistance from the state or federal government. Upon a finding of public purpose, the city may disburse the assistance to any person to be used for economic development projects, including but not limited to the purchase or improvement of land and buildings for residential, commercial, or industrial use.

Sec. 2. Section 403.6, Code 1983, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. Subject to applicable state or federal regulations in effect at the time of the city action, accept contributions, grants, and other financial assistance from the state or federal government to be used upon a finding of public purpose for grants, loans, loan guarantees, interest supplements, technical assistance, or other assistance as necessary or appropriate to private persons for an urban renewal project.
