2 1983, is amended to read as follows:

3 All written reports filed by a law enforcement officer
4 as required under section 321.266 shall be made available
5 to any party to an accident, the party's insurance company
6 or its agent, or the party's attorney, on written request
7 to the department and the payment of a fee of four dollars

8 for each copy. If a copy of a report is retained by the law
9 enforcement agency of the officer who filed the report, that
10 copy shall be made available to any party to the accident,
11 the party's insurance company or its agent, or the party's
12 attorney, on written request and the payment of a fee of four
13 dollars for each copy.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill allows a copy of the law enforcement officer's
16 accident report to be obtained from the law enforcement agency
17 as well as from the department of transportation.

18 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

Section 1. Section 321.271, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

All written reports filed by a law enforcement officer as required under section 321.266 shall be made available to any party to an accident, the party's insurance company or its agent, or the party's attorney, on written request to the department and the payment of a fee of four dollars for each copy. If a copy of an investigating officer's report of a motor vehicle accident filed with the department is retained by the law enforcement agency of the officer who filed the report, a copy shall be made available to any party
