1 Section 1. Section 714.2, subsection 2, Code 1983, is

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill makes theft of a motor vehicle valued in excess
14 of five thousand dollars a class "C" felony, punishable by
15 confinement for not more than ten years and a possible fine
16 of up to five thousand dollars. Theft of a motor vehicle
17 (other than a motorized bicycle) valued at less than five
18 thousand dollars would remain a class "D" felony, punishable
19 by confinement for not more than five years and a possible
20 fine of up to one thousand dollars. The penalty for theft
21 of a motorized bicycle would depend on its value.

22 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

RELATING TO THE PENALTIES FOR THE CRIME OF THEFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA

Section 1. Section 714.2, subsection 2, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

2. The theft ~~by any person~~ of property exceeding five hundred dollars but not exceeding five thousand dollars in value or theft of a motor vehicle as defined in chapter 321 ~~sevenpenteve-of not exceeding five thousand dollars in value.~~ is theft in the second degree. Theft in the second degree is a class "D" felony. However, for purposes of this subsection, "motor vehicle" does not include a motorized
