2 as follows:

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill repeals the requirement that the legislative
23 service bureau conduct a study every four years to determine
24 if the formula for computing the portion of the motor fuel
25 tax attributable to fuel used in watercraft needs revision.
26 The bill does not change the current statutory distribution
27 ratio (section 324.84). The moneys are deposited in the
28 marine fuel tax fund to be appropriated for the conservation
29 commission's recreational boating program. The bill is
30 effective July 1 following enactment.

REPEALING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A STUDY TO DETERMINE THE PERCENTAGE OF MOTOR FUEL TAX COLLECTED THAT DERIVES FROM MOTOR FUEL USED IN WATERCRAFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 324.84, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

324.84 TRANSFER TO MARINE FUEL TAX FUND. Pursuant to ~~section 324.83, there shall be transferred~~ The treasurer of state shall transfer from the motor fuel tax fund to the marine fuel tax fund a created in section 324.79 that portion of moneys collected under this chapter ~~which is~~ attributable to motor fuel used in watercraft ~~which portion shall be~~ computed as follows:

1. Determine monthly the total amount of motor fuel tax collected under this chapter and multiply ~~such the~~ amount by nine-tenths of one percent.

2. Subtract from the figure computed pursuant to subsection 1 of this section three percent of ~~such the~~ figure for administrative costs and further subtract from ~~such the~~ figure the amounts refunded to commercial fishermen pursuant to subsection 14 of section 324.17.
