5-2710 1 An Act to appropriate the principal, interest and earnings  
2 from the special fund for the Herrick bequest to certain  
3 projects.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 644

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the special fund  
2 established by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1265, from the interest  
3 and earnings of the funds in the special fund, the following  
4 amounts or so much thereof as may be necessary to the agency  
5 designated for the following purposes:

6 1. To the state board of regents  
7 for the redevelopment of the west  
8 approach of the old capitol building ..... \$160,000

9 2. To the state fair board for  
10 site planning and initial develop-  
11 ment of heritage village ..... \$ 50,000

12 3. To the state conservation  
13 commission for the following purposes:

14 a. An Iowa arboretum in Boone  
15 county ..... \$ 50,000

16 b. A depot restoration on a  
17 recreational trail and corridor

23 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the special fund

29 EXPLANATION

30 This bill appropriates the interest and investment income  
31 from the funds of the Herrick bequest to certain capital  
32 projects. The bill also appropriates one million dollars  
33 of the principal for the planning of a new state historical  
34 building or center.

35 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.
