1 Section 1. Section 400.11, unnumbered paragraph 3, Code

3 Except where ~~such~~ the preferred list exists, persons on

6 certification, except for certified eligible lists of fire
7 fighters as defined in section 411.1, subsection 3, which
8 lists shall hold preference for three years upon approval
9 of the commission, after which ~~said~~ the lists shall be canceled
10 and ~~no~~ promotion to ~~such~~ the grade shall not be made until
11 a new list has been certified eligible for promotion.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill allows certified eligible lists of fire fighters
14 to hold preference for promotion for three years upon approval
15 of the civil service commission. The bill is effective July
16 1 following its enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CERTIFIED ELIGIBLE LIST FOR PROMOTION FOR CITY CIVIL SERVICE.

I hereby certify that this bill originated in the Senate and is known as Senate File 116, Seventieth General Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 400.11, unnumbered paragraph 3, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

Except where such the preferred list exists, persons on the certified eligible list for promotion shall hold preference for promotion for two years following the date of certification, except for certified eligible lists of fire fighters as defined in section 411.1, subsection 2, which lists shall hold preference for three years upon approval of the commission, after which said the lists shall be canceled
