1 An Act abolishing the council on child abuse information.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 235A.12, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
2 1983, is amended to read as follows:

3 The purposes of this section and sections 235A.13 to ~~235A-24~~
4 235A.23 are to facilitate the identification of victims or
5 potential victims of child abuse by making available a single,
6 ~~state-wide~~ statewide source of child abuse data; to facilitate
7 research on child abuse by making available a single, ~~state-~~
8 wide statewide source of child abuse data; and to provide
9 maximum safeguards against the unwarranted invasions of privacy
10 which such a registry might otherwise entail.

11 Sec. 2. Section 235A.13, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
12 1983, is amended to read as follows:

13 As used in sections 235A.12 to ~~235A-24~~ 235A.23, unless

15 Sec. 3. Section 235A.24, Code Supplement 1983, is repealed.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill abolishes the council on child abuse information
18 and amends the sections of the Code which had referred to
19 it. This bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

ABOLISHING THE COUNCIL ON CHILD ABUSE INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 235A.12, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

The purposes of this section and sections 235A.13 to ~~235A.24~~ 235A.23 are to facilitate the identification of victims or potential victims of child abuse by making available a single, ~~state-wide~~ statewide source of child abuse data; to facilitate research on child abuse by making available a single, ~~state-wide~~ statewide source of child abuse data; and to provide maximum safeguards against the unwarranted invasions of privacy which such a registry might otherwise entail.
