7 inches, ~~where the mobile home or factory-built structure does~~

9 ~~the hitch or any overhang~~, and where the overall length of  
10 the mobile home or the factory-built structure and the power  
11 unit does not exceed eighty-five ninety-five feet.

12 EXPLANATION

13 The current law allows the movement of a mobile home or  
14 a factory-built structure under a single trip permit on the  
15 highways of the state where the overall length of the mobile  
16 home or factory-built structure and the power unit does not  
17 exceed eighty-five feet. The bill removes the limit on length  
18 of the home or structure and increases the maximum overall  
19 length to ninety-five feet. The bill takes effect July 1  
20 following enactment.

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SINGLE TRIP PERMIT TO TRANSPORT A MOBILE HOME OR FACTORY-BUILT STRUCTURE ON THE HIGHWAYS OF THE STATE WHERE THE OVERALL LENGTH OF THE MOBILE HOME OR FACTORY-BUILT STRUCTURE AND THE POWER UNIT DOES NOT EXCEED NINETY-FIVE FEET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321E.28, subsection 1, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

1. Single-trip permits issued under ~~the provisions of~~ this section shall be limited to mobile homes and factory-built structures of widths including appurtenances exceeding twelve feet five inches but not exceeding sixteen feet zero inches, ~~where the mobile home or factory-built structure does not exceed sixty-seven feet six inches in length including the hitch or any overhang,~~ and where the overall length of
