1 Section 1. SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FROM COUNTIES. The board
2 of supervisors of each county shall appropriate from its
3 county general fund the sum of two thousand five hundred
4 dollars to be paid to the brucellosis and tuberculosis
5 eradication fund created under section 165.18 in the office
6 of the secretary of agriculture. The payment from each county
7 is due and payable to the secretary of agriculture on July
8 1, 1984.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill provides that each county appropriate two thousand
11 five hundred dollars from its county general fund to provide
12 temporary funding for the brucellosis and tuberculosis
13 eradication fund created in the office of the secretary of
14 agriculture. The special appropriation will provide moneys
15 for the fund from July 1, 1984 until the first tax collections
16 from each county are available for this new fund not later
17 than December 15, 1984.

18 This bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
