1 Section 1. Section 472.21, Code 1983, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 472.21 APPEALS--HOW DOCKETED AND TRIED. The appeal shall
4 be docketed in the name of the person appealing and all other
5 interested parties to the action shall be defendants. In
6 the event the condemner and the condemnee appeal, the appeal
7 shall be docketed in the name of the appellant which filed
8 the application for condemnation and all other parties to
9 the action shall be defendants. The appeal shall be tried
10 as in an action by ordinary proceedings. The appraisalment
11 of damages by the compensation commission is admissible in
12 the action.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that the appraisalment of damages by
15 the compensation commission in a condemnation proceeding shall
16 be admissible in an appeal of the award.
