1 Section 1. Section 155.37, subsection 2, paragraph c,  
2 Code Supplement 1983, is amended by striking the paragraph.

3 EXPLANATION

4 The paragraph stricken required that drugs on the  
5 nonequivalent list not be dispensed. The list was apparently  
6 only intended to alert pharmacists that these generically  
7 equivalent drugs, although they have been approved for sale,  
8 may pose therapeutic problems which may require adjustment  
9 for the patient. This bill takes effect July 1 following  
10 its enactment.
