1 Section 1. Section 257.12, Code 1983, is amended by  
2 striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:

4 257.12 QUALIFICATIONS OF SUPERINTENDENT. The  
5 superintendent shall possess an Iowa certificate issued under  
6 chapter 260 with an administrator's endorsement. The deputy  
7 superintendent shall possess the same qualifications.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill strikes the requirement that the superintendent  
10 of public instruction must hold or be eligible to hold an  
11 Iowa superintendent's certificate and have five years  
12 experience in education administration and requires that the  
13 superintendent possess an administrator's endorsement.

14 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

Section 1. Section 257.12, Code 1983, is amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

257.12 QUALIFICATIONS OF SUPERINTENDENT. The superintendent shall possess an Iowa certificate issued under chapter 260 with an administrator's endorsement. The deputy superintendent shall possess the same qualifications.
