RELATING TO PAY SCALE STANDARDS FOR MEMBERS OF THE IOWA NATIONAL GUARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 29A.27, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:
