EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that publication of a full-time county
22 employee's salary is required annually rather than each time
23 the employee is paid. The bill takes effect July 1 following
24 its enactment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 349.18, Code Supplement 1983, is amended to read as follows:

349.18 SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS--EACH PAYEE LISTED--
PUBLICATION. All proceedings of each regular, adjourned, or special meeting of ~~boards~~ a board of supervisors, including the schedule of bills allowed, shall be published immediately after the adjournment of the meeting ~~of the boards~~, and the publication of the schedule of the bills allowed shall ~~show the name of each individual to whom the allowance is made and for what purpose the bill is filed and the amount allowed,~~ include a list of all claims allowed, including salary claims for services performed, showing the name of the person or firm making the claim and the amount of the claim, except that names of persons receiving relief shall not be published and salaries paid to persons regularly employed by the county shall only be published annually showing the total amount of the annual salary.
